Launches High School Essay Contest**

POZEN Inc. and the Chamber Foundation for a Sustainable Community are holding an essay contest open to all high school students currently enrolled in Chapel Hill-Carrboro City Schools. The essay contest officially began on October 17, 2007. Students are asked to respond to the question, “What improvements would you like to see in your community with respect to environmental stewardship, social equity and economic prosperity?” The contest ends at 9am Friday, November 16th.

The first place winner will be awarded \$500 with an additional \$100 awarded to the teacher who assists that student with their essay. The second place winner will be awarded \$300, and the third place winner will be awarded \$200. The winning students will be recognized and will receive their awards at the Foundation for a Sustainable Community’s Salute to Community Heroes on the night of December 6, 2007 at the Carrboro Century Center.
